## PRESS STATEMENT ON THE RELEASE OF THE 2015 KCSE EXAMINATION RESULTS

- 1.0** The Kenya National Examinations Council (KNEC) wishes to inform candidates, parents / guardians, stakeholders and the general public that the 2015 KCSE Examination results will be released by the Cabinet Secretary, Ministry of Education, Science and Technology on **Thursday, March 03, 2016**. The release ceremony will be at **Mitihani House** in **Caledonia** on **Denis Pritt Road** opposite **St. Georges Girls High school** starting from **9.00 a.m.**
- 2.0** In preparation for the release of the Examination results, candidates, principals and parents / guardians are advised as follows:-
  - 2.1** To access the **2015 KCSE Examination** results, send the candidate's index number through a short message service (**sms**) text to **22252** immediately after the release by the Cabinet Secretary.
  - 2.2** Upon receipt of the Examination results, thoroughly scrutinize the results for correctness and ensure accuracy of, the **names, index number, gender; school name, code; and individual subjects**.
  - 2.3** Any discrepancy noted on the Examination results and any appeals for re-marking should be **COMMUNICATED TO KNEC AS A QUERY** within **one month (30 working days)** from the date of release of the examination results.
  - 2.4** Candidates with withheld/pended results will receive a letter through the respective head teacher explaining why the examination results have been withheld/pended.
- 3.0** The County Directors of Education (CDEs') are advised to collect the results slips immediately after the release of the examination results.
- 4.0** Upon the release of the results, they will be available on KNEC Website [www.knec.ac.ke](http://www.knec.ac.ke).
